

Hello Band Families!

On behalf of Mrs. Jenn Light & the Band Parents Association Executive Board, welcome to the 2023-24 Carlynton Golden Cougar Marching Band! This season will be my 8th as a band parent, my 6th as a board member, and my 1st as CBPA President! I am truly looking forward to supporting our wonderful students, families, directors, and staff in every way possible.

Honestly, I consider it a privilege to be part of this organization, as it is made up of phenomenal young musicians, dancers, and twirlers who are exceptionally talented. Each season they impress me greatly with how hard they work and the care they show for each other.

Whether you are brand new to the CGCMB or a seasoned parent/guardian like myself, you play an important part in helping create the best possible experience for not only your student(s), but the entire band. With that in mind, I have a few requests:

- **Stay Informed!** The best way for us to communicate with each other is through email. Please send your email address to ***carlynton.marching.band@gmail.com*** to be added to the band email list for important information. Any questions can be sent to this email & will be directed to the person best able to help. Be sure to refer to the band calendar on the website (***carlyntonband.com***) for frequently updated report times & events. Finally, sign up for the REMIND app so that you get last minute reminders and updates promptly.
- **Get Involved!** There are lots of ways for you to support the band throughout the season, and volunteer opportunities to suit everyone's schedules & strengths, so please don't stand back! Most of our volunteer positions require you to have the proper Clearances on file with the school, and the completion of the District's Volunteer Form. If you haven't already, please begin that process as soon as possible, as we will not make any exceptions. Let me know if you have any issues or questions, because ***your support & involvement is critical to the success of the band & the experience of our students.***

To begin each year, the Board issues a "Packet" of essential information that includes e v e r y t h i n g from performance dates to shoe order forms, as well as both the Student and Parent Handbooks. Mrs. Light and the CBPA Board have worked hard to provide these detailed guides, so please read through and then complete all forms as necessary. We will provide a printed copy of the handbooks for easy reference throughout the year, and forms will be made available to complete online if you wish. We even have a "Form Checklist" for you to keep track, because **ALL information is required for your student to participate in the CGCMB.**

Your Packet includes the "Assessment Letter", with a complete explanation of the CGCMB costs, how to submit the first payment (due to Jennifer O'Leary on or before the first day of Band Camp), and ways to reduce this financial obligation through volunteering and fundraising. Again, downright excessive details about this can be found in the Parent Handbook.

Drillmaster marching shoes will be ordered again this year. Members are required to have marching shoes and will be able to try on sample shoes at band camp to get the proper fit before orders are sent in

All members of the band are fitted for their uniform during camp. I'm excited to see how our new uniforms help reduce the time needed for this process! If you should ever need assistance with your child's uniform, please contact Bridget Buriak, our Uniform Chairperson. "Show Shirts" are provided for all band members and are traditionally worn on the last day of Band Camp for the Family Preview Day. Additional shirts are available for purchase since many of our parents & guardians like to wear one at games and parades! A link to order online will be sent out to everyone, or please submit the hard copy form included in the packet.

If you have any questions regarding the forms & handbooks, please do not hesitate to ask me via email (the band one or my personal email), call, or text.

As you know, time seems to speed up as our kids get older. So here are a few items to add to your calendar right now to avoid missing out!

Rookie Camp => July 18th, 19th, and 20th 10 am - 12 pm.

This is for every new band member, regardless of grade. Rookies will learn basic marching, rehearse some music, and generally prepare to jump into full Band Camp with everyone else. Returning band members - especially Section Leaders & Captains - are encouraged to come out & help get the rookies off to a great start. Special sessions for the Drumline will also happen during these times.

Full Band Camp => July 31st - August 4th and August 7th - 11th , 8 am - 2:30 pm

These 2 weeks are essential & mandatory for ALL band members. This is when the pregame and halftime shows are set and memorized, uniforms are fitted and assigned, music is rehearsed, and much more. Most importantly, this is when everyone learns to work together as a TEAM! If there are any questions and/or conflicts regarding Band Camp attendance, please contact Mrs. Light as soon as possible at jennifer.light@carlynton.k12.pa.us

Look for details about theme days and special treats we provide during Band Camp. These are very important traditions to the students, but without help, some of them simply cannot happen. Watch for those volunteer requests to come through via email, and sign up promptly so everything can be well planned!

Finally, specific forms must be turned in on the first day of Band Camp. Please review the checklist when you receive your packet and be sure that you have submitted all required forms either online or via mail. ****No one will be allowed to participate in Band Camp without these forms on file.****

Carlynton Golden Cougar Festival of Bands => Saturday, September 16th, 2023.

The festival is always a fantastic & memorable evening, showcasing not only the CGCMB but many local bands as well!. I am very excited for this year's event and strongly encourage you to participate for its success. This is one of our biggest fundraisers every year, and the profits benefit our band members in multiple ways. Please watch for sign-ups to help with the festival! Band Festival Program ads will be for sale by students soon. Ads are a great way to celebrate, share baby pictures, & raise money for your child! 50% of all ad sales goes directly into the band account of the selling band member.

Last but certainly not least, I invite you to attend our monthly meetings. We meet at 7 pm on the first Tuesday of every month in the high school band room (unless noted differently on the band website calendar). There are no meetings in July or December. This is an important monthly update on fundraising, events, & planning. It is strongly encouraged that parents and guardians attend regularly so that everyone is kept abreast of opportunities & happenings.

As President, my personal goals are to focus on Communication and Teamwork between all who are involved in the Marching Band. Some of the ways I am working toward those goals have already been put in motion, which you may notice as the additions to the Parent Handbook, the opening up of CBPA meetings to students, and (hopefully) in my perfect *Poker Face* when dealing with everything from conflicts to *Applause*. I hope you will commit to helping me achieve these goals in order to avoid any sort of *Bad Romance*, because when we are motivated to communicate well, then our team functions well, and our Golden Cougars will certainly reach *The Edge of Glory*!

Dear Band Parent / Guardian / Student,

Before you know it Band Camp will be here, so we are sending this letter to inform you about the 2023-2024 marching band season assessment for the Carlynton Band Parents Association. The assessment fee is \$130.00 per student. As in the past, **if the parent or guardian volunteers at four functions per student, then your assessment will be reduced to \$90.00.**

This assessment is a mandatory participation fee for marching band. Some of the expenses it covers are uniform cleaning and repairs, band members' banquet ticket, band camp, liability insurance (required), letterman jacket refund after 3 years of participation, refreshments for all games and activities (includes refreshments for visiting bands), senior gifts for senior night, band camp supplies & expenses, senior albums, website domain, and other miscellaneous expenses for the band.

The first installment of \$50.00 is to be paid **ON** or **BEFORE** the first day of Band Camp, July 31, 2023. The second and final payment is due October 1, 2023.

As in the past, if a student's assessment has not been paid and their account is not in good standing, then the student will not be permitted to perform until it is corrected (paid). Please sign and detach the bottom portion of this letter, indicate whether you will be deducting the payment from your student's account or if you will be enclosing a check. Your signature authorizes the Band Parents Association to deduct the payment from your student's account and that you accept the terms of this letter. Checks should be made payable to Carlynton Band Parents Association (CBPA). **We also accept payment through Venmo. Use @Carlyntonmarchingband and make sure you write 'Assessment' in the notes.**

Auxiliary Uniform Care Instructions:

(For the lycra velvet/velour uniforms put into service 2016/2017)

Auxiliary members are given a clean uniform at the beginning of the band season. It is the Auxiliary member's responsibility to keep the uniform clean for each event.

Alterations

If mud splashes onto velvet, let it dry completely, THEN brush it off with a dry towel. Turn uniform inside out and **HAND WASH ONLY** in cold water & mild detergent. **DO NOT** soak. **DO NOT** wring or twist. Line Dry.

Hand wipe with dish soap.

Machine wash warm, dry on low heat.
